ABOUT THE WINEMAG.CO.ZA TASTING PROGRAMME 2022

Winemag.co.za is set to produce a series of category reports over the course of the year with multinational financial services company Prescient as sponsor. Each report will be based on the outcome of a blind tasting of wines entered within a specific category.

A report includes key findings, tasting notes for the top wines, buyer's guide and scores on the 100-point quality scale for all wines entered. Upon release, producers can purchase both Top 10 and regular rating stickers – consumers are encouraged to look out for these in the retail environment.

JUDGING PROCEDURES

The judging panel was chaired by me and further consisted of two trusted colleagues, namely Ndaba Dube, Food & Beverage Operations Manager at the President Hotel, Cape Town and Francois Rautenbach, Singita Premier Wine Direct General Manager. We tasted blind, labels out of sight. Ratings were done according to the 100-point system, final scores awarded on the basis of discussion that involved retasting where necessary rather than relying solely on arithmetic averaging.

KEY FINDINGS

Rotundone is a chemical compound responsible for the peppery, spicy aromas and flavours in Shiraz/Syrah wines. Interestingly around 20% of the population are unable to perceive the characteristics the compound imparts. The variation in individual sensitivity to rotundone suggests that the way wine is assessed by consumers or wine judges could vary substantially from one person to another. Moreover, the argument might well be made that even if tasters are able to perceive rotundone, they still might take a view that this is a characteristic that they don't like or value on account of its apparent harshness.

If, however, rotundone is viewed as a desirable property in Shiraz then it is worth noting that in general, cooler ripening and limited bunch exposure appear to favour the synthesis and/or accumulation of the compound. A key winery process to elevate pepper aroma and flavours, meanwhile, is whole-bunch fermentation, which is to say intact rather than destemmed bunches included in the fermenter — this should still be done with caution as it can also result in "cutgrass" and "herbal" aromas as well as increasing tannin concentration, which if overdone, can lead to excess astringency.

For this year's category report sponsored by Prescient, there were 99 entries from 82 producers with 59 (60%) rating 90-plus on the 100-point quality scale. Clearly, winemakers are now very adept at elevating the concentration of rotundone but the key question remains: Is this what consumers want?

One of the key reasons Merlot supposedly succeeds commercially is its reputation for being smooth textured rather than possessing any particular flavour. The best Shiraz, on the other hand, is nothing if not peppery and many will have quite grippy tannins as a result of wholebunch fermentation. While Merlot tends to be safe but dull, Shiraz/Syrah certainly is not that. Suffice to say then, Shiraz is for those who aren't afraid of some flavour intensity.

Average price of the 59 wines to rate 90-plus is R247 a bottle and of the Top 10 is R186. Offering the best quality relative to price is Du Toitskloof with a rating of 94 and selling for R80 a bottle.

Eenzaamheid 2020

Price: R195

Total Production: 4 000 bottles Abv I4%

20% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 11 months in larger format oak barrels. Expressive aromatics of red berries, musk, fynbos, cured meat, pepper and spice while the palate has a great core of fruit with zippy acidity and crunchy tannins. Harmonious and packed with flavour.





Wildeberg 2021

Price: R360

Total Production: 3 540 bottles Abv 14%

85% Syrah and 15% Cabernet Franc. 30% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 18 months in older oak. Hugely fragrant on the nose — red and black berries, musk, fynbos, pepper and spice. The palate shows lovely fruit purity, bright acidity and lightly grippy tannins — has a wonderful energy about it, the dash of Cab Franc adding extra intrigue.





Great Five Reserve 2019 (Stellenview Premium Wines)

Price: R135

Total Production: 12 000 bottles Abv 14%

Matured for 14 months in older oak. Grapes from Durbanville and Stellenbosch. Compelling aromatics of red and black berries, lilies, pepper plus some smoky reduction while the palate has good fruit density, bright acidity and smooth tannins. A wine with a sense of reined-in power.





Harry Hartman Somesay 2021

Price: R330

Total Production: 6 640 bottles Abv 12.52%

Grapes from Cederberg, Ceres-Plateau, Piekenierskloof, Stellenbosch and Swartland. 50% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 11 months in a combination of second- and third-fill 225-litre barrels plus a 1000-litre foudre. Complex aromatics with notes of red and black berries, lilies, fynbos, olive and pepper while the palate has great fruit concentration, fresh acidity and crunchy tannins. Not without heft despite the relatively low alcohol.





Org de Rac 2020

Price: R120

Total Production: 6 666 bottles Abv 14.49%

Matured with staves for 14 months in French and American oak barrels, 70% new. Heady aromatics of red and black berries, fynbos, cocoa and pepper. The palate is full bodied and flavourful with a dense core of fruit, bright acidity and nicely grippy tannins.





Diemersdal 2021

Price: R110

Total Production: 40 000 bottles Abv 13.57%

Matured for 12 months in 225-litre barrels, 30% new. Red berries, rose, fresh herbs and white pepper on the nose while the palate shows pure fruit and zippy acidity before a saline finish. A striking wine with lots of detail.





Du Toitskloof 2019

Price: R80

Total Production: 86 000 bottles Abv I4%

Grapes from Breedekloof and Swartland. Matured for 10 months using a combination of barrels and staves. Attractive aromatics of red and black berries, fynbos, musk and pepper while the palate is juicy and fresh with powdery tannins. Good concentration and texture.





Gentis Badlands 2021 (Thor Vintners)

Price: R250

Total Production: I 236 bottles Abv I 4.79%

86% Shiraz, 7% Ruby Cabernet and 7% Touriga Nacional. Aged for 10 months in 1 000-litre stainless steel tank with staves. Red and black berries, fynbos and pepper on the nose while the palate show good depth of fruit, fresh acidity and crunchy tannins. Full but balanced — no shortage of vibrancy.





Groote Post 2020

Price: R178

Total Production: 4 420 bottles Abv 14.60%

Matured for 14 months in 90% French and 10% American oak, 25% new. Aromatics of red and black berries, fynbos and flowers, pepper and spice while the palate displays dense fruit, bright acidity and crunchy tannins. This has weight but also drive — a polished wine with layers of flavour.





Sunkloof Reserve 2019 (Stellenview Premium Wines)

Price: R99

Total Production: 15 000 bottles Abv 14.38%

Matured for 14 months in older oak. Grapes from Durbanville and Stellenbosch. Compelling aromatics of red and black berries, floral perfume, fynbos, cured meat and pepper while the palate is full but balanced – good fruit concentration, bright acidity and a dry finish. Plenty of interest.
